Note from the General Manager ~

Seen any Ball Marks on our greens? A mark fixed when it happens will repair in 1-2 days. Left untreated can take up to 21 days to repair itself. ***If nothing else, please remember this*** - push your ball marks back toward the center; ***do not lift*** or ***twist*** harshly. Please help us keep our greens looking their best.

Many of you may have seen Josh Reasoner back out here working on extending the right wall of the 16/17 dam spillway. He has done all of these modifications at no expense to the club since his original design did not contain the amount of water we have had over the dame this spring. We hope the final adjustment will do the trick.

We still have plans for continued renovations to the golf course. We plan to start the new green for #8 next month with its new tee boxes. Irrigation will be extended to cover the new fairway and green. Additionally, we still plan to do some work on several tee boxes this fall. We are also planning to continue work on cart path extensions that are still needed on several holes.

Members are always asking what they could do to help the club. One of the biggest ways you can help your staff is to make tee times for your groups so that we do not have open tee times that outside guest can book during the times that members want to play. If each group would have a representative check with the golf shop once a week or once a month and make sure that all the times that you want to play are booked for your group it will reduce the conflict with outside play especially on the weekends.

Our club needs the outside play as well as we need year round members. I need your help to make sure that both groups have the best possible experience while they are here playing golf.
